RULEI VIÑA BARRACALLO 2011

It comes from Viña Barracallo, a wine of Tempranillo and a little of Cabernet-Sauvignon, the second experimental variety of the vineyard.

This wine with its dense colour and its intensity reveals perfectly its stony soil and the Rulei philosophy.

Ageing: 18 months in French and American oak barrels (50%-50%) of 225I.

<u>Tasting:</u> Intense ruby red colour with a terracotta edge. Toasted aromas with balsamic and mineral notes, liquorice and cocoa. Structured but friendly and sweet tannins, with a long persistence.
